
## Hampton Roads Regional Transportation Priority Projects

## What Makes HRBT Unique

#### First bored tunnel for VDOT

- 2<sup>nd</sup> largest TBM in North America
- 3<sup>rd</sup> bored vehicular tunnel in the US

#### No impacts to Navigable Waterways

New tunnel will be 173 FT below water surface

#### Minimal Impacts to Traveling Public

- Segments shipped by barge
- Spoils hauled by water


#### Continuous Operation

- Not subject to adverse weather
- Able to continue 24/7 without interruption



#### **Tunnel Boring Machine & Slurry Treatment Plant**







#### **Slurry Treatment Plant**





- Manufactured in France
- Stands 3 stories tall
- Separates soil from slurry
- Spoils pumped to surface through 22-inch steel pipe
- Operates 24 hours a day
- Largest STP in North America




## **Tunnel Segments**



- Fabricated in Cape Charles,VA
- 9 segments = I ring
- Average Dimensions = 16' x 6'-6" x 18"
- Each segment weighs roughly 10 tons
- 2,388 rings will be needed to complete both tubes








#### **Features**

- 16'-6" Clearance
- Egress corridor
- Jet fan ventilation
- 15,000 truckloads of base material
- More than 1 million square feet of tile

- Construction began in 2021
- Installed to date:
  - 305 54" precast piles
  - 44 precast caps
  - 324 girders
  - 38 concrete deck pours
- Traffic shift to new eastbound trestle May 2024




# Virginia's Military Value




#### Strategy to Action

- Win basing of the Next Generation Air Dominance (NGAD) fighter.
  - Oceana
- Pursue additional JSOC/SOF and Fleet basing at Joint Expeditionary Base Little Creek/Fort Story (JEBLC-FS)
- Investigate opportunities for the future of Naval Mine
   Countermeasures (MCM) missions at Naval Station Norfolk
- Establish a Commonwealth-wide IGSA
- Build upon the success of compatibility programs (DCIP, REPI)
- Coordinate agreements with Dominion Energy to increase power capacity and create cost savings.
- Toll assistance or reimbursement for installations in the Hampton Roads area.
